## **1. Unpacking Your Washout booth**

- A. Make sure when you receive the booth that the box containing the booth is un-damaged and intact. if it is damaged, a claim must be filed with the freight company that delivered the booth.
- B. Take all the parts out of the packed container. You should find the following:
- 1 - Bottom Basin
  - 1 - Back Panel
  - 2 - Side Panels
  - 4 - Legs
  - 23 - 1/4"-20 x 3/4" Pan Head Bolt (large)
  - 15 - #8-32 x 1/2" Pan Head Bolt (small)
  - 23 - 1/4" Lock Washers (large)
  - 15 - #8 Lock Washers (small)
  - 23 - 1/4"-20 Cap Nuts (large)
  - 15 - #8-32" Cap Nuts (small)
  - 1 - Screen Rack
  - 1 - Assembly Manual

## **2. Washout Booth Assembly**

- A. Attach legs to Bottom Basin using 4 - each of 1/4"-20 x 3/4" Bolts (large), Lock Washers (large) and 1/4" Cap Nuts (large) (see image). When leg is secured, tighten all nuts. When all four legs are attached, place the assembly upright.



- B. With the Booth Basin and Legs attached, place the Back Panel in place and secure with 1/4"-20 x 3/4" Pan Head Bolt (large) on the inside of the Basin and Lock Washers/Nut Caps (large) on the outside. (Finished Phillips nut on the inside of Basin).



- C. Hold the panels in place, secure to Booth Basin with 4 - each 1/4"-20 x 3/4" Pan Head Bolts/ Lock Washers/Nut Caps (large). Secure Side Panels to Back Panel with 14 - each #8-32 x 1/2" Pan Head Bolts (small) on the inside and Lock Washers/Nut Caps (small) on the outside.



- D. Tighten all nuts on Back and Side Panels and remove any protective film on any of the pieces.
- E. Place Screen Rack in Bottom Basin

### **3. Plumbing**

- A. Have a licensed plumber attach proper drain fittings to the bottom fitting.
